ORDERING REPEAT MEDICATION

Requests for repeat medication will be processed and ready for collection within 48 hours. Some exceptions to this rule will be for medication not previously issued or where we are awaiting confirmation of the drug and dosage from the hospital. We will always try to keep you informed of any likely delay.



Did you know that you can order repeat medication on line? If you would like to start using this service we will need to provide you with a password to allow you to access your information. Please ask at the reception desk and we will provide you with instructions on how to do this.

If you live more than 3 miles from the surgery we are able to dispense your medication for you at the surgery without you having to go to the local chemist. If you are interested in signing up for this service please speak to a member of the reception team.
